Built, owned, and operated by Rutenberg Commercial Developers, THE FOUNTAINS PLAZA is a two-level specialty theme center in Palm Harbor, Florida. It features more than 50 shops, restaurants, and services, set among fountains and courtyards. Sitting on an 11 acre North Pinellas County site just off US 19, The Fountains is a compact center of approximately 85,000 square feet. Showcased at the center is a food emporium that features imported and domestic food, wines, meats, seafood, baked goods, and produce being sold by individual purveyors in an indoor open market setting. The architectural design reflects a strong Mediterranean influence with its fountains, terra cotta, abundant landscaping, and central clocktower.
